Friends of the Library (FOTL) continues to advocate for literacy throughout our community via our Little Free Library (LFL) program. Two new LFL book-sharing boxes were installed over the last few months. In May, a drive-thru style LFL was installed at the Findlay Township Municipal Building in Clinton. In June, a LFL was unveiled at the entrance of the North Fayette Community Center at Donaldson Park.

Little Free Libraries do not require a library card or any check out process! Any and all readers are encouraged to visit one of the five LFLs in the community and take a book to read. There are materials for all reading levels and interests. When you are done with your book you may share it with someone else or return it to any of the LFLs. If you have books you would like to share with your community, feel free to add them to a LFL. The selections in each book box are rotated once a month.

In addition to these two new LFLs, please visit existing book boxes at the Walden Woods main entrance on Evergreen Run, at the Findlay Township Community Center in Imperial, and in the Oakdale Parklet on Noblestown Rd. (across from the gazebo).
