Our vision is for West Allegheny to be a vibrant, inclusive, connected, and informed community that is committed to lifelong learning.



## **Programs**











- Western Allegheny Community Library offered 823 programs that were attended by 15,732 patrons.
- 1419 Patrons attended a library offered STEM program.
- 53 Programs were offered for teens, which were attended by 613 individuals.
- 3800 Patrons attended 130 outreach programs.
- 196 Storytimes (consisting of Baby Rhyme Time, Littles Storytime, and Sensory Storytime) were attended by 4717 patrons.

### **Preschool Outreach**



Through a partnership with Monark Student Transportation and West Allegheny School District, we were lucky to have received a *new* Book Bus last year. Our Book Bus, unveiled in August, now visits 7 area preschools and daycares throughout Findlay, North Fayette, and Oakdale each month. Miss Lexi visits 16 classrooms, bringing a movement filled storytime experience to over 400 children.

## Notable Achievements & Strategic Partnerships

- Awarded the commonwealth's PA Forward Gold Star status for the fifth year in a row.
- The Library Director was named Ambassador of the Year for the Pittsburgh Airport Area Chamber of Commerce, for the second consecutive year.
- Fall for Your Library was yet again a success, raising over \$57,990.
- Awarded the Legislative "Celebrating Communities" Grant, which is being used to create sensory friendly kits for circulation as well as the creation of a Sensory Room for patrons.
- Renewed our designation as an Educational Improvement Organization through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Department of Community and Economic Development and was awarded \$3000 in funding via First Commonwealth Bank's Educational Improvement Tax Credits.
- Received Emergency Connectivity Funding to cover the cost of four additional hotspots for residents without internet.
- The Friends of the Library placed two more new Little Free Libraries throughout the community, which they restock and rotate on a regular basis. The libraries were created by students at the High School.
- Replaced the awnings at both the front and back doors.
- Replaced the last of our drainage pipes that had become damaged over time.
- Expanded our *Libraries Are for Everyone* programming series which intentionally creates programs for individuals with intellectual disabilities in mind.
- Partnered with Chatham University and hosted three Occupational Therapy Doctoral Student Interns during their fall semester.
- Launched the 100 Books Before High School reading program.
- Hosted field trips for the High School Life Skills Program and Resurrection Preschool.
- Partnered with over 35 local businesses and organizations for program offerings (including Museum of Natural History, BOK. Law & Mediation Services, Community College of Allegheny County, Huntington Bank, Chatham University, Pittsburgh Glass Center, and Dementia Friends).








## **Financials**
